Program Overview

By participating in the International Green Building Internship Program, you stand to gain international work experience, the opportunity to network with experts in the field, to get started on your career path, and to contribute to cutting edge green building activities and programs around the world.

Internship placements are open to qualified undergraduate and graduate level students who are registered in an accepted program at an Ontario university or college. Internship responsibilities may include assisting with educational programs, rating tool development, membership management, green building research, logistical support for events and workshops, administrative support, etc.

Participating students will receive a \$3000 stipend and will be eligible to receive a mobilization award to help offset air travel costs.
